



## INVITATION TO EMPLOYERS: WORK PLACEMENT FOR LOWER VI STUDENTS

The Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) is inviting interested employers to participate in its programme for the placement of Lower VI students in enterprises for a period of 2 weeks during the school holidays. The objective is to complement a students' academic studies with on-the-job practical work experience and to bridge the gap between school and the world of work.

### **Relevant information:**

- There is no limit to the number of trainees that an employer can accommodate.
- Payment of a stipend to students is at the discretion of the participating employer.
- The HRDC will provide an Insurance cover for all students during their placement.
- The workplace must be fully compliant with current health and safety and all other legal requirements.

Employers may enlist Lower VI students during the following period in school holidays for the year 2014:

- 07 April to 18 April 2014
- 28 July to 08 August 2014
- 03 November to 26 December 2014
