National Training & Reskilling Scheme (NTRS)

Registration of Training Service Providers

Government is implementing an Economic Recovery Programme which comprises a package of measures aimed at boosting GDP growth, protecting jobs and creating new ones, reducing dependence on imports and improving the well-being of the population.

One of the key components of the **Economic Recovery Programme** is the **National Training and Reskilling Scheme (NTRS)** targeting some 9,000 unemployed persons who will be trained in fields including construction, manufacturing, logistics, ICT/BPO, agro-industry, renewable energy and circular economy for a duration of up to 6 months.

In this connection, the Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) is inviting approved training institutions to register themselves with the HRDC under the NTRS so as to be considered as potential service providers to dispense training in the following fields:
